Financial Aid Available

ADULT 1-LICENSURE

- Build to seeing 10 Clinical hours per week in exchange for tuition and supervision (excluding control supervision)
- Required Participation in Clinical Process Group
- Possibility to apply for additional blocks of time as a W-2 employee
- Candidates with mental health degrees working toward license to practice independently can see 5 patient hours per week in exchange for half tuition

Adult Program (Unlicensed) | 10 clinical hours

Adult Program (With Mental Health Degree)

Option to see 5 patient hours per week and pay half tuition | \$2,800

Adult Program (Licensed to practice independently): Option to work in blocks of time at the ICC as a 1099 | \$5,600
