

# **CAP PROGRAM**

Develop a private practice, with the most up-to-date training and research program in New York.

CAP not only will provide training to work well with infants and adolescents, but to help you achieve your professional goals, to have more flexibility, and to develop a wider new approachable psychoanalytic view.

In CAP, we based our training on the best research on attachment theory, having an emphasis on infant observation. We believe that the child and adolescents can not be treated on their own, as they are part of a family. Even when working with parents might be difficult, we train professionals to engage the parents and other family members in the therapeutic process. This approach gives us a much wider real impact by breaking the barrier that could keep us from doing an integral work within the child and adolescent family context.

## **HOW TO APPLY**

### REQUESTED INFORMATION

Applicants should have a Masters or Doctoral degree in a mental health profession.

The application takes an average of 16 minutes to complete and most people do so on a PC or laptop. Since the application is detailed, having the following documents on hand before you begin is a good idea:

- · Your resume saved in PDF format
- Names and dates of attendance of educational institutions
- Personal treatment details including the name, address, phone number and affiliation of the therapist
- Dates of treatment, number of sessions per week
- Details of your experience as a psychotherapist in a clinical setting (if any) including the institution, name of supervisor and dates.
- Details of your private training as a psychotherapist in private practice (if any) including the name of your supervisor, frequency of supervision and dates
- The names of two references and their addresses and date of your professional relationship
- · Two admissions interviews are required

#### REFERENCE LETTERS

The application requires two Letters of Recommendation.

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
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
