RESPECIALIZATION 1

- · Shadowing of Intakes in Fall Semester
- Supervised Intakes Starting in January
- Begin seeing a patient in psychotherapy with the aim of building up to three patients
- · Required Participation in Clinical Process Group

RESPECIALIZATION 2

- Intakes
- · Continue developing clinical cases as appropriate
- · Required Participation in Clinical Process Group

ADULT 1-LICENSURE

- · Participation/Observation in Clinical Setting · Build to seeing 10 Clinical hours per week in exchange for tuition and supervision (excluding control supervision)
 - · Required Participation in Clinical Process Group
 - · Possibility to apply for additional blocks of time as a W-2 employee
 - Candidates with mental health degrees working toward license to practice independently can see 5 patient hours per week in exchange for half tuition

Adult Program (Unlicensed) | 10 clinical hours

Adult Program (With Mental Health Degree) Option to see 5 patient hours per week and pay half tuition.

Adult Program (Licensed to practice independently): Option to work in blocks of time at the ICC as a 1099.
